QuestBridge National Match Scholarship. Assists high-achieving, low-income students in gaining admission and full four-year scholarships to leading universities. More information and application found at www.questbridge.org. **Deadline: September 30, 2009.**

Texas Student Housing Scholarship. Open to students accepted to colleges in Austin, College Station, or Denton, TX, that have not signed off-campus housing leases. This scholarship awards academic and leadership excellence. **Deadline: January 31, 2010.**

AXA Achievement Scholarship. Information and scholarship application at www.axa-achievement.com. **Deadline: December 15, 2009.**

National Co-Op Scholarship Program. Must have a GPA of 3.5, and must apply and attend 1 of 8 NCCE Partner Colleges and Universities. Applications and additional information at www.co-op.edu. **Deadline: February 15, 2010.**

Carr Academic Scholarship. Must be accepted to Angelo State U., be in the top 45% of your class and score a min. SAT of 1020 (math and cr) and 22 ACT. Awards range from \$1000 to \$3000 annually. For best chance meet priority **deadline of Dec. 1, 2009.**

Presidential Scholarships. UTA Honors College will offer 20 scholarships of \$6000. Scholarships are awarded solely on the basis of academic merit. **Deadline: Feb. 15, 2010.**

Terry Foundation Scholarships. Sixteen incoming freshmen at UTA will receive these scholarships based on student's need. Awards typically average \$55,000 over a four-year period. **Deadline: Feb. 1, 2010.**

Collins Scholarships. Scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated leadership and service abilities and are accepted to Baylor U. Collins Scholars are awarded \$4350 each year, renewable for 4 years. Must be in top 25% of class, have 1250 SAT (math and cr) or 28 ACT, and have completed a college prep program in high school. **Deadline: Jan. 1, 2010.**

Texas Art Scholarship. Merit-based in the amount of \$5000 awarded to students majoring in visual arts. May be used at the college or university of the student's choice. **Deadline: March 1, 2010.**

Gates Millennium Scholars. One 1000 students are selected based on the eligibility criteria of being an African American, American Indian, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American, are a US citizen, have a GPA of 3.3, have demonstrated leadership abilities, meet Federal Pell Grant eligibility criteria, and have all forms completed. **Deadline: Jan. 11, 2010.**

Terry Foundation Scholarships. High School students who have been admitted to the following universities are selected: TAMU, UT-Austin, U of Houston, UTD, UT-San Antonio, Texas State. Contact the financial aid offices at these universities to apply. **Deadline: contact university.**

Tarleton State University Presidential Honors Program Scholarships of \$7000 awarded to academically talented students with a commitment to excellence. Must be in top 10%, 27 ACT or 1190 SAT. For more information see www.tarleton.edu/honors.

Wilson N Jones Foundation Scholarship Must have a 2.5 GPA, enroll for min. 12 college hrs., complete at least one college class toward a healthcare related field. **Deadline: March 3, 2010.**

Texas Telephone Association Scholarship Five, \$1500 per yr. scholarships will be awarded to TX high school graduates. Must have a 3.0 GPA, and attend a TX college or university.
