Regents' Scholars Program

The Regents' Scholars Program (RSP) scholarship package is valued at approximately \$20,000, which equates to approximately \$5,000 per year. This four-year scholarship is provided to 30 students each year and provides them with a study abroad experience between their junior and senior year. Students pursue a bachelor's degree while developing their awareness of international issues and cultural contrasts. In addition, RSP provides students with leadership training and experience that will allow them to have a positive impact upon the lives of others on campus, and in their future profession. The typical Regents Scholar has the following characteristics: ACT score of 27 and/or SAT score of 1200 (critical reading and math) and graduates in the top 10% of their high school class. First Year Leadership Class

The First Year Leadership Class (FLC) Program equips students with the personal leadership skills and education necessary to lead their class through the upcoming four years and creates a closer-knit Texas A&M University-Commerce community. FLC allows participants to take an active role in the campus and Commerce community through service-learning activities. Students receive leadership training valued at \$2,500. This is a competitive scholarship opportunity (\$1250 per fall/spring semesters for freshman year) for our top student leaders with
